It is an ASEAN project in which Singapore is the host country and Singapore Philatelic Museum is the coordinating organisation.

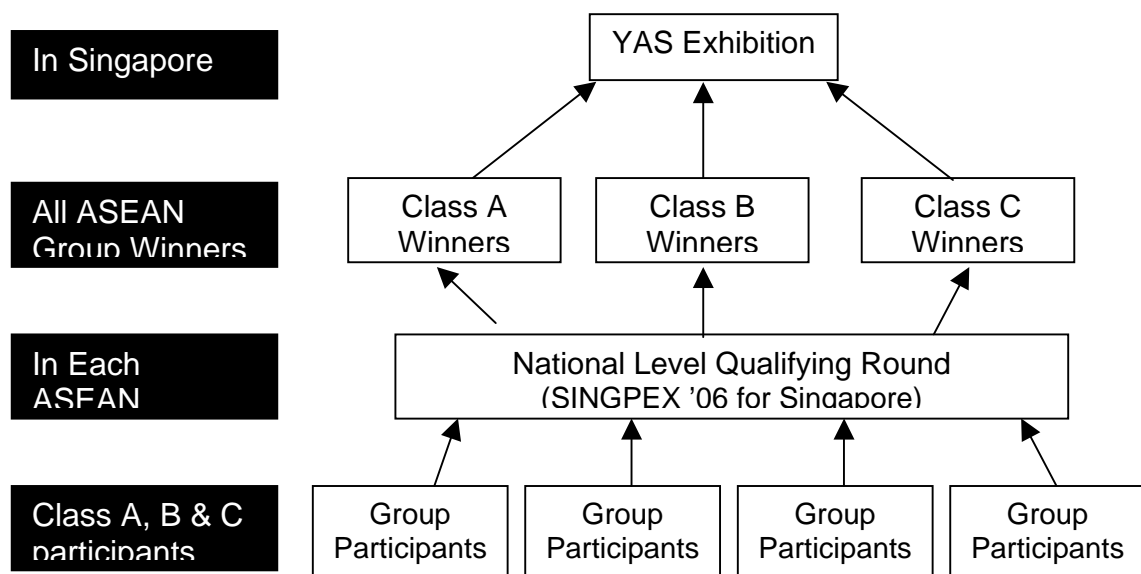


Objectives of YAS Exhibition

- To encourage youths and educational institutions in ASEAN countries to use stamp collection as a learning and educational tool.
- To provide a platform for exchanges of creative ideas, knowledge and information sharing, and interaction through philately.
- To foster closer inter-ASEAN understanding and relationship through philatelic activities.
- To develop research skills, writing skills, management and organisational skills; and encourage creative thinking.

The ASEAN countries are Brunei Darusalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam.

National Qualifying Level For YAS Exhibition

ASEAN Countries

Each ASEAN country will hold the national qualifying round for group participants of 12 – 18 years old from June to December 2006.

Group participants will compete according to their age ranges organised in three classes:

- Class A: 12 – 13 years old
- Class B: 14 – 15 years old
- Class C: 16 – 18 years old

Winners of each Class at the national qualifying level are eligible to compete with other ASEAN winners at the YAS Exhibition held in Singapore in August 2007.
