Draw My Stamp Story Art Competition 2019 is organised by Singapore Philatelic Museum (SPM). The competition will be held in August'19. Winning entries will be displayed at the National Library from 28 August 2019 – 2 September 2019. The Prize Giving Ceremony is scheduled on **Friday, 30 August 2019, 3:00pm – 4:30pm** at The Plaza, National Library.

OBJECTIVES OF COMPETITION

- Help students to understand and appreciate the importance of the designs reflected on our Singapore stamps;
- Allow students to express their creativity in the background design they create to complement the stamp(s) and to think out of the box;

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- Individual Category is opened to **Primary 3 – Primary 6** school students and **Secondary 1 – Secondary 4** school students.
- Each student is entitled to submit **1 entry only**.
- No restriction for number of students participating per school. But each school must shortlist the students works for best entries before submitting the works to the museum.
- At the back of each artwork, the following details must be captured:

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Artwork must be completed on an **A4 sized, landscape oriented white drawing block paper**.
- Only **Singapore stamps** must be used in each artwork. The stamp(s) must be **unused (mint)** and each entry can use a **minimum of 1 stamp or a maximum of 3 stamps**.
- Only stamp(s) must be pasted onto the drawing block paper. Other objects such as stickers, plastic gems, wool etc. pasted onto the artwork **will be disqualified**.
- Entries using **computer graphics or computer designs will be disqualified**.
- Colour pencils, crayons, markers, water-colours or oil paints can be used to create the hand drawn artwork.
- Entries deemed offensive would be rejected.
- Singapore Philatelic Museum owns the copyright and usage rights of the artworks.
- **The Jury's decision is final**. Objections to the Jury's decision will not be entertained.
