**SCHOOL GROUP CATEGORY (CLASS 4)**  
**RULES & REGULATIONS**

The National Stamp Collecting Competition 2019 (NSCC '19) is organised by Singapore Philatelic Museum (SPM) and supported by Ministry of Education. The competition will be held in August '19. Winning entries will be displayed at the National Library from 28 August 2019 – 2 September 2019. The Prize Giving Ceremony is scheduled on **Friday, 30 August 2019, 3:00pm – 4:30pm** at The Plaza, National Library.

**Objectives of Exhibition**

- Promotes the collection and study of postage stamps and other philatelic materials;
- Cultivates ties and friendship among philatelists;
- Demonstrates the cultural and educational value of philately and its attractiveness as a hobby.

**Submissions**

- Date: **Friday, 12 July 2019**, by **5.00pm**. All **Exhibits** must be submitted **by hand** to Ms Lily Samuel, Singapore Philatelic Museum, 23-B Coleman Street, Singapore 179807.

**Conditions of Participation**

- Participation in Class 4 is opened to **Pri 3 – Pri 6 & Sec 1 – Sec 4** school students.
- Each group must have **4 members** and entitled to **1 entry per group**.
- No restriction for number of groups per school.
- Groups must submit entries based on a theme of their choice eg. transportation, flowers, animals, technology, culture, festivals, royalty, sports etc.

**Rules and Regulations**

- Participants will make use of philatelic materials (4 different philatelic materials on each page), and **minimal text** to share about a subject or theme of the group's choice.
- Entries must be typewritten.
- Entries must contain at least **60% of philatelic materials on each page** i.e. mint stamps, used stamps, **first day covers (must be windowed)**, miniature sheets, commercial covers, maxicards, stamp booklets, aerogrammes etc.
- Secondary School Entries must comprise:  
**Min 16 A4-sized exhibition sheets (1 frame) or max 48 A4-sized exhibition sheets (3 frames)**
- Primary School Entries must comprise:  
**Min 8 A4-sized exhibition sheets (½ frame) or max 16 A4-sized exhibition sheets (1 frame)**

**Security Measures**

- SPM will take all reasonable precautions to ensure that adequate security is provided to protect the entries from the time they are received until they are returned after the exhibition. SPM will not bear any liability for any damage or loss to the entries.

**Handling of Exhibits**

- Entrants must bear the cost of delivering the exhibits.
- Teachers/Parent Volunteers to endorse all submitted entries.
- All entries will be returned after the exhibition period.

**Judging and Awards**

- Entries will be judged on philatelic knowledge (**all philatelic materials must be captioned**), originality of idea, content, research effort, development and innovation of story-line, condition of materials, appropriate use and proper mounting of philatelic materials and presentation.
- Gold & Silver Awards will receive trophies, all participants will be awarded certificates and schools stand to compete for the Championship trophy.
- **The Jury's decision is final.** Objections to the Jury's decision will not be entertained.
