WHO DELIVERS OUR MAIL?

Do you know what happens when you drop your letter into the posting box? What is the sequence of mail? Who is responsible for the collection and delivery of mail? Invite a 'postal worker' to your school, take part in fun hands-on activities and find out more about mail delivery at the interactive *Who Delivers Our Mail?* programme!

Highlights:

Children will meet a postal worker who can guide the children on how he/she helps the community. Children will get to enhance their literacy as they get to read the address on the envelope and "mail" their letter into the correct slot. Children will learn to collect mail, cancel stamps and prepare the envelopes ready for delivery.


STAMPS THAT TICKLE OUR SENSES


MY STAMP COLLECTION


NATIONAL STAMP COLLECTING COMPETITION WORKSHOP

- \$5.00 per pax (Min 20 pax, Max 40 pax)




SINGAPORE PHILATELIC MUSEUM TALK
